## 2017-2018 Parent and Family Engagement Survey Summary Results (H-1)

Number of Parents Surveyed

160

### Section 1 – Did you receive information from your child’s school about awareness of standards and testing?

Sixty-eight percent of the parents surveyed had knowledge of the information that was used to determine whether their child moves to next grade or is retained.

### Section 2 – Did you receive materials from your child’s school about helping your child with school?

Only sixty-three percent of the parents indicated that they received materials to help them work with their child(ren) to do better in school.

### Section 3 – Did you and your child’s school collaborate?

While fifty-four percent of parents felt that the school valued their suggestions for their child’s learning.

### Section 4 – Did you and your child’s school have an open line of communication?

Sixty-six percent reported that if needed, translators were available and able to help during parent meetings and other school activities.

### Section 5 – Was your child’s school open to parental Involvement?

When asked whether they requested specific activities, meetings, or materials from their child’s school, seventy-three percent of the parents answered, “Yes.”  
Seventy-one percent of the parents surveyed felt the parent meetings were flexible and offered at different times.

### Where did you get information about standards, testing, and helping your child succeed in school?

Overall 92% of the parents seemed to be aware of Standards and Testing, knowledgeable when it comes to assisting their child(ren) with school, how to act as effective partners, satisfied with communication, district/school’s openness to parental involvement.

The data generated from the deficient areas will be reviewed and analyzed with the School Advisory Council (SAC), and used to plan the parent and family engagement activities for the 2018-2019 school year.
